- The trustees of School District 46 (SD46) are pleased to welcome Annalisa Achee to the role of student trustee for the 2022-2023 school year. Annalisa Achee was sworn in on September 14th at the Regular Meeting of the Board in Gibsons. Achee is the 10th student trustee in the district's history. She is sure to continue the rich legacy of having an influential student voice at the Board table. The Board of Education's Strategic Plan includes as its first goal, "Our students' voices will be respectfully heard and acted upon."
- The board has approved the preliminary budget, and approved the audit process. We are looking really good for the coming school year and the audit process was flawless.
- The board is sending letters to the provincial and federal government to advocate for increased annual, reoccurring spending on food, rather than for only this one year, which we received over \$400,000 in grant funding for! The Food in Schools committee has been hard at work at investigating hot lunch, breakfast and take-home food programs for students, based on need by school and individual students and families. Thank you to all of you who completed the survey this past spring / summer your input was greatly appreciated!
- A new board has been elected my six fellow trustees will be returning and we are happy to welcome the new trustee, Ann Skelcher who is a retired teacher and principal with SD46! I know her input will be very valuable and I am happy she was elected.
